Business Session

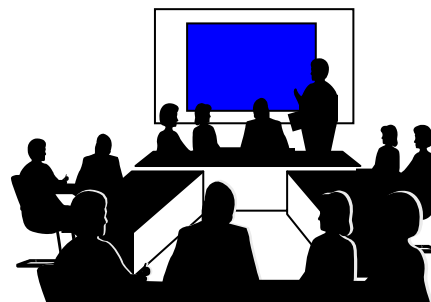
